The Student Activity Fee Committee met on November 2, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. 464 Student Center West and took the following actions:

I. Approval of Minutes

Asna Ash moved to amend the September 12, 2018 minutes as follows:

“Include introduction discussion on the University Wide Designation for Student Organizations”

This motion was seconded by Renee Bazemore. With no other objections the minutes were approved.

II. University-Wide Designation for Student Organizations – Discussion & Vote

Renee Bazemore moved to create a University Wide Designation pilot for FY2020 for those student organizations who chose the designation with an allocation budget of \$5,000. The motion was seconded by Jessica Siemer. (Attachment 1).

III. FY 2020 Fee Councils & Colleges Allocation – Discussion & Vote

Jessica Siemer moved to decrease/increase the allocations for the Colleges and Fee Councils as follows:

Amendment (1): Increase Arts Fee Council by \$8,025 to \$235,277
 Increase Student Bar Association by \$968 to \$68,981

Amendment (2): Increase Arts Fee Council by \$1,500 to \$236,777
 Decrease Atlanta Campus Wide by \$1,500 to \$102,265

Amendment (3): Increase Arts Fee Council \$1,000 to \$237,777
 Decrease Student Government Association by \$1,000 to \$142,364

Amendment (4): Increase Arts Fee Council by \$938 to \$238,715
 Decrease ISAC by \$938 to \$70,000

Amendment (5): Increase Colleges by \$1,000 to \$297,581
 Decrease Diversity Fee Council by \$1,000 to \$101,040

III. FY 2020 Fee Councils & Colleges Allocation – Discussion & Vote

Amendment (6): Increase Arts Fee Council by \$1,000 to \$239,715
Decrease Student Government Association by \$1,000 to \$141,364

Amendment (7): Increase Student Bar Association by \$500 to \$69,481
Decrease Academic Teams by \$500 to \$193,833

University-Wide Designation for Student Organizations

Rationale: The consolidation of Georgia State University with the five campuses of Georgia Perimeter College created an opportunity for student organizations to accept membership from students across all campuses of the university. However, the current administrative processes only provide approval for student organizations to be recognized on one campus or campus-wide at the Perimeter College locations. A university-wide designation for student organizations will provide an opportunity for interested organizations to recruit members from the entire student body.

Currently chartered student organizations interested in the university-wide designation would indicate interest in the university-wide designation during the upcoming annual renewal process for their campus. As new student organizations petition to charter, they can request the university-wide designation during the chartering process.

Requirements for University-Wide Designation

- Membership should be open to students at all Georgia State University campuses
- Student membership from one campus should not exceed 75% of total membership
- Student organizations should actively recruit membership from students at all Georgia State University campuses
- Meetings and/or events must be held on at least four campuses per academic year
- One of the four campuses must be the Atlanta campus (A college-wide designation for organizations already exists on the Perimeter College campuses)
